**Professional Education Requirements**

- ES 2000 must be completed with a “CB” or better for advancement to the Secondary Education Curriculum and enrollment in professional education courses at the 3000 level or above.
- An application to the upper professional level must be completed after the following requirements are met:
  - Passing scores on all three sections of the MTTC Professional Readiness Exam #96 (formerly the “Basic Skills Test”)
  - Completion of a background check from CertifiedBackground.com (Use package code WC48)
  - Completion of all intellectual skills development courses (if needed)
  - Successful completion of a College Level Writing course
  - Completion of 60 credit hours with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- A minimum grade point average of 3.0 must be earned in ED 3000, ES 3950, SPED 4290, LS 4050, ED 4060, ED 4065, ED 4085, ED 4086, and the Methods of Teaching course(s) for internship and recommendation for the teaching certificate.
- Courses must be taken in sequence and all prerequisites met as indicated.
- Upper professional level education courses can only be repeated **one** time.
- All Secondary Education program courses as listed below require a “CB” grade or better.
