The Michigan Department of Education revised their Year Out Survey in 2022. Therefore, we do not have the same employment data that we received in 2020 and 2021 (see page 2). The 2021-22 Year Out Survey data below indicates that new teacher graduates around the state and at WMU were unhappy with their preparation for a job search during the height of the pandemic in 2020.

## WMU 2020-21 and 2019-2020 Teacher Education Graduates' Employment Data from the Michigan Department of Education 2021 and 2020 Year Out Surveys

The Michigan Department of Education changed their survey questions for First Year Teachers in 2020. Therefore, we can only provide two years of data from the new survey below.

As the table below indicates, WMU first year teachers in both years overwhelmingly reported being employed in a Michigan school setting. 2020-21 graduates were much more likely to be employed in a teaching position (90% vs. 42%) while 2019-2020 graduates were more likely to be employed in the district in which they completed their internship (97% vs. 32%).
