Priority registration is a benefit available to TRiO FESP students that ensures students get an advantage to registering for courses. To earn priority registration each semester, students must complete an appointment with a FESP staff member each semester, have all required FESP assessments completed/submitted, and attend an academic or career related workshop or complete an online module. Students will receive an email reminder with the requirements and workshop and online module options every semester.
