What You Need to Know



Green and yellow gas has a pungent odor, but will not burn skin



Compressed chlorine gas may explode if heated



In compatible with many common chemicals, very reactive

What it Can do to You

Inhalation

Irritation to nose and throat, tightness in chest and wheezing, asthma and death Skin Contact
Frostbite, blistering,
and burning skin

Eye Contact
Burning eyes, or possible blindness

Long Term Effects
Sever damage to the repertory system
