

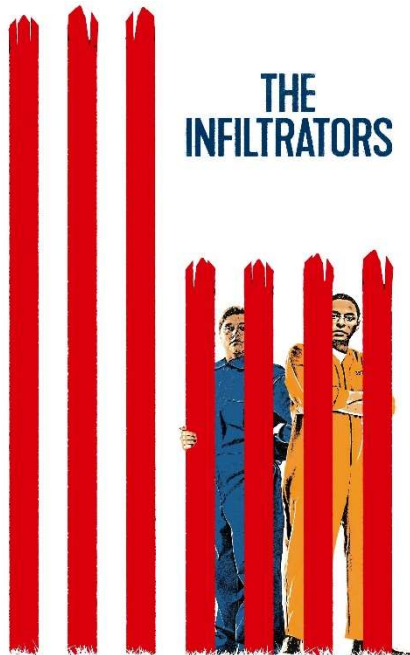


Migration and Human Rights Film Discussion Series - Join us!!
