PROGRAM FEE \$10,523

Program fee includes tuition, administrative costs, airport transfer, pre-departure and on-site orientations, room and board with 3 meals/day and Wi-Fi access, 24/7 on-site staff support, medical insurance, excursions [Manuel Antonio National Park, Northern Panamá, Arenal Volcano, cloud forest and hot springs, white water rafting, rainforest canopy ziplining, etc.], cultural activities [museum visits, coffee and chocolate tours, National Theatre production, cooking and dance classes, city tours, hiking and horseback rides, etc.], on site printing, computer lab and campus-wide Wi-Fi are also available.
