UNIBE Courses

Students shall study in the Bachelor program of their choice at UNIBE for the first three years. Students who complete the first three years' courses at UNIBE with a CGPA of 3.0 or above, and meet WMU's English proficiency and academic requirements, shall be considered for admission to the Master's program of their choice at WMU, which is expected to last approximately two years.

WMU Courses

Students shall take all required courses for the Master's program of their choice. Course requirements can be found in the current WMU Graduate Catolog.

Graduate Catalog

Students participating in the CAMP will be required to submit proof of their Bachelor's degree from UNIBE in order to be conferred a Master's degree by WMU.

Students are encouraged to meet with their academic advisors at both WMU and UNIBE to ensure they will meet all of the requirements to graduate.
