Under Charge #3, Metro-Roland suggested adding that three faculty curriculum internationalization grants had been awarded as of the end of spring 2019. In addition, Hahn suggested that the report could include the fact that the council had reaffirmed language of a prior memorandum of action related to the University's Global Engagement Award to focus on faculty. Finally, McMorrow stated that under Charge #4, the council had worked to identify diversity and inclusion committees for each college and to contact them related to their efforts regarding international issues in their work.
