Applying for the <u>Expedited Master's Program</u> in Special Education at WMU

Thank you for your interest in applying with us! Please follow the step-by-step instructions for submitting your application.

- 1. Starting from the Expedited Master of Arts in Special Education with Initial Teaching Certification page, click on **Apply**
- 2. This should open the Graduate Student Applications page. Click on **Degree Seeking** which should be the first option.
- 3. This will open a page about starting your application. Scroll to the bottom and click on **Start Your Application**
- 4. Sign in or set up an account with GraduateWMU
- 5. Once you are on the homepage, click on **Start New** in the bottom right corner
- 6. At the start of a new application, make the following selections to start the correct application:
 - 1. Select international or domestic depending on your status
 - 2. Select **Master's** as your degree option
 - 3. Select **online** as your campus option
 - 4. Select **Special Education:** <u>Clinical Teacher- MA</u> as your program [this program is for individuals earning their *first* special education endorsement]
 - 5. Select your readmission option(likely no)
 - 6. Select Spring 2024 as your term of choice

- 8. In your written statement, please mention the following:
 - Which endorsement are you seeking? The options are:
 - o Autism

- o Learning Disability
- o Emotional Impairment
- If you have been selected or are interested in receiving funding through Grow Your Own (GYO) or Talent Together (TT). This is funding available through districts.
- That you are interested in the expedited program
- 9. Once your application is complete, please review and submit the application.
- 10. Once your application is fully submitted, faculty will begin their review. This typically takes 1-2 weeks. If you have not heard from us after 2 weeks, please email Lynda Root: lynda.root@wmich.edu, who can check on your application status.
