What we do.

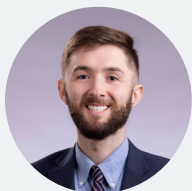

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1:1 CliftonStrengths Coaching

CEHD 2010: Academic Discovery

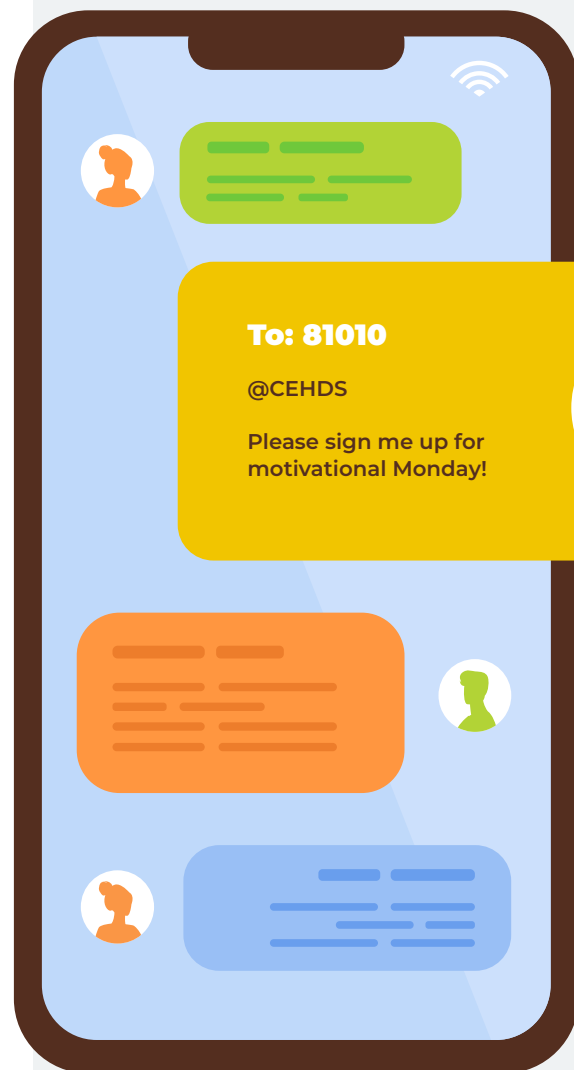
This one credit hour course is designed to increase students academic skills and grow as a college-level learner. Course is offered in the fall and spring.
