C. Clear graphic illustration of the proposed innovation.

clearly enhances an existing product

ii. Client population

D. A detailed, line-item budget that includes items necessary to complete the innovation.

- E. Implementation Plan: A timeline for development, production of the innovation, and proposed dissemination of the innovation.
- F. Evaluation Plan: Detailed methods used to determine the intended outcomes of your innovation.

If your proposal is accepted, you will be required to provide an interim report (six months after funds are awarded) and a final report (one year after funds are awarded).
