The Bernie Iversen Scholarship in Engineering is awarded annually to students pursuing degrees in Mechanical or Aerospace Engineering. Awards of \$3,333 are given to individual students to help with financial need. Awards may be given to 3 undergraduate students or 2 undergraduate students and 1 graduate student each year.

Guidelines:

- Recipients shall be full-time students in good standing in the Mechanical Engineering or Aerospace Engineering majors or graduate programs
- Recipients shall be Michigan residents, as defined by Western Michigan University's Residency Policy
- Recipients shall have demonstrated financial need
- Undergraduate and graduate students are eligible to receive the scholarship. For undergraduate students, the scholarship is renewable for one year and students can re-apply if they are eligible. For graduate students, the scholarship is not renewable.
