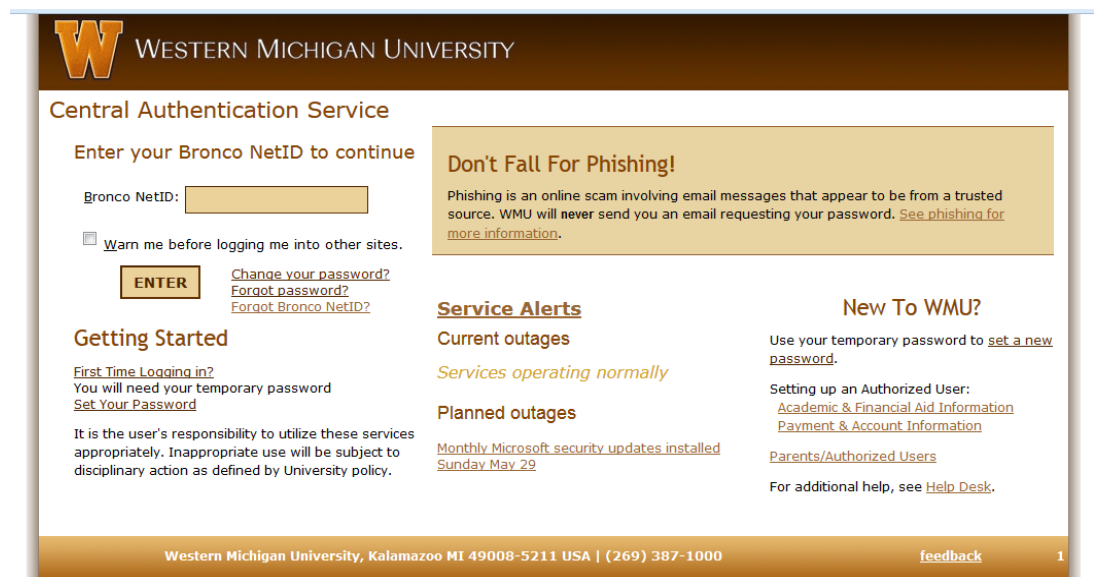

Step 1— Logging into GoWMU

1. Log in to GoWMU.
2. Enter your Bronco NetID and password.
3. Click “Login” or press “Enter.”



Step 2— Address Validation

1. After you have logged into GoWMU, click on the “Course Offerings” link under your Student Home Tab. The address validation information will appear.
2. Click “Update Ethnicity” - optional to fill out but must click the submit button to move forward.
3. Review your address and check the box that you have validated your address and phone numbers.
4. Click “Submit” and click the “Back to Student Home Tab” link in the upper left.

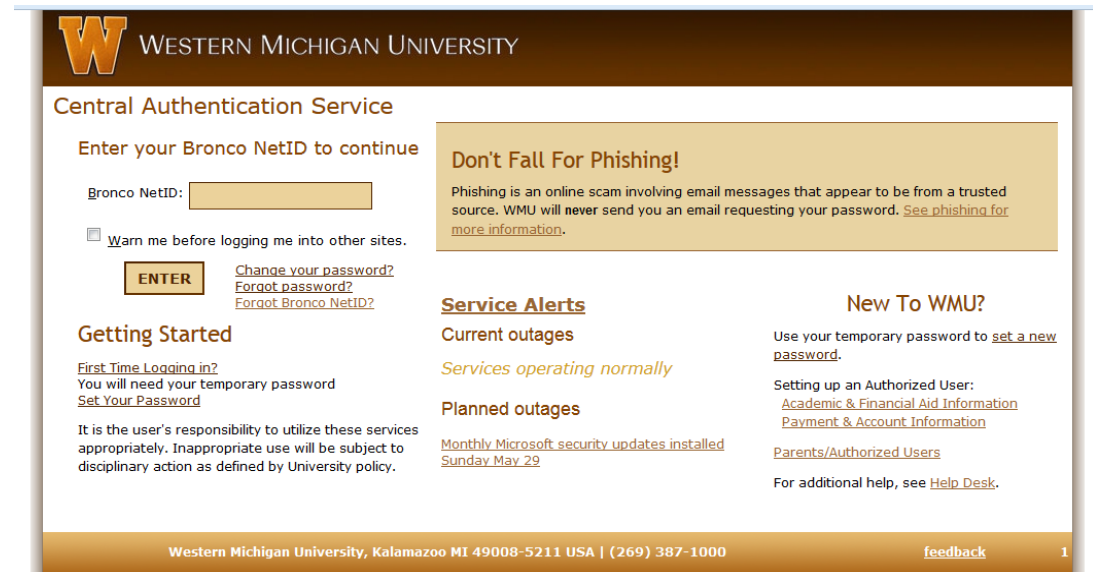

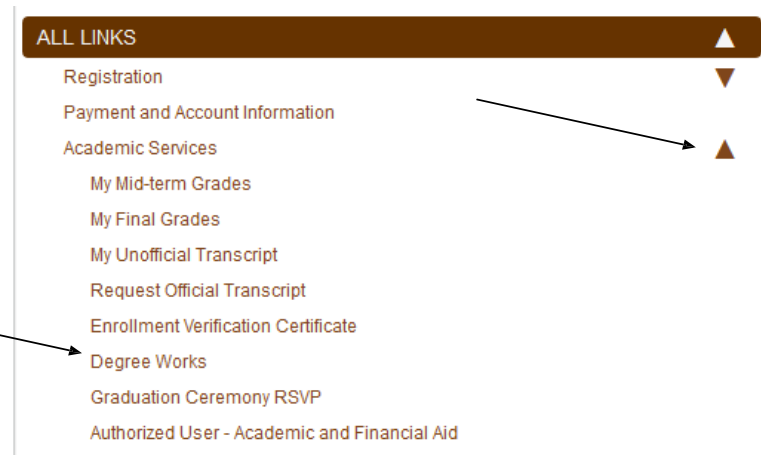
Step 1— Logging into GoWMU

1. Log in to GoWMU.

Step 2 – Accessing DegreeWorks

1. After you have logged into goWMU, select the triangle next to “Academic Services.”
2. Select “DegreeWorks”
3. Your DegreeWorks should open in a separate window.
If it is not opening, check your pop-up blocker. If needed, enable pop ups.



Step 3 – Locating WES Courses

1. Once you have DegreeWorks open, scroll down to the heading “WMU Essential Studies (WES).”
2. The areas are on the left of your screen. To the right are the classes that will fulfill each area.
