# Advanced Competency Compendium (ACC)

## What is the ACC?

The ACC is a digital portfolio of specific assignments from each of your concentration level courses that measure each of the 9 MSW competencies. The ACC is not a summary test or a thesis defense. This is one of the two assessment tools the School of Social Work uses to collect and report on competency levels for MSW Concentration students, and to evaluate our curriculum.

## How do I complete my ACC?

### Identify Assignments

Policy, Planning, and Administration (PPA)

Concentration Students:

Complete the ACC assignment specified in SWRK 6430, 6690, and 6700

Clinical Social Work

Concentration Students:

Complete the ACC assignment specified in SWRK 6660, 6680, 6685, and 6900

Instructors: Make sure the common assignment for courses included in the ACC (above) are clearly described in your syllabus

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### Save in E-Learning

Students: Download your ACC assignment with instructor feedback, and upload to the dropbox for the MSW Advising and Assessment course in e-learning

Instructors: Make sure to provide feedback on ACC assignments in track changes and then upload to e-learning so students can download and add to their ACC portfolio in MSW Advising and Assessment course

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### Turn in ACC

Students: Share your ACC portfolio items with potential employers, neighbors, and pets to show off your wicked social work skills. You can access your ACC portfolio even after you graduate using your BroncoNetID and password

Instructors: Complete the ACC spreadsheet with the level of competency for each student and each competency assigned and send to the School for inclusion on our assessment data
