Elective Recommendations for Some Graduate Programs

Clinical PSY	PSY 3300 (prof 2 bacc writing), PSY 2500 and 3240, and 2 of the following based on interest: PSY 2517, 3517, 4280, 4526, or 4630: Applied and Research Practicum
Forensic PSY	PSY 3300 (prof 2 bacc writing), PSY 3260, 2500, 3240 and 5240; Applied and Research practicum
Counseling PSY	PSY 3300 or 4526 (prof 2 bacc writing), PSY 2500, 3240, 4280 and 5240 (Other PSY electives could be taken based on interest)
School Counseling	PSY 3300 or 4526 (prof 2 bacc writing), PSY 2500, 3240, 3517 and 5240 (Other PSY electives could be taken based on interest)

A minimum of nine (9) credit hours must be taken toward the major from the WMU Psychology Department

***You must declare with the Psychology Advisor for any courses requiring Pre-PSY or an official major declaration in order to register**
